

Bihar Deputy CM seeks end to Farakka water release obligation

Patna, 8 September

Bihar Deputy Chief Minister Vijay Kumar Choudhary said on Tuesday that the state's interests had been ignored on issues related to the India-Bangladesh Farakka Water Treaty and the Farakka Barrage. He demanded that the obligation to release 1,500 cusecs of water during the lean period be abolished.

Addressing a press conference in Patna, Choudhary said that when the Farakka Water Treaty was signed in 1996, there was a UPA government at the Centre and a government in Bihar led by Lalu Prasad Yadav. Both governments, he said, ignored Bihar's interests and did injustice to the state.

The JD-U leader said that, in order to comply with the provisions of the Farakka Water Treaty, Bihar is required to release 1,500 cusecs of water during the lean period. This,



he said, leads to drought-like conditions in several parts of the state.

At the same time, he said, the largest share of water entering the Ganga comes through Bihar's tributaries. Therefore, it is essential that Bihar's water interests be given priority.

Choudhary categorically stated that the obligation on Bihar to release 1,500 cusecs

of water during the lean period should be abolished. This water could instead be used in Bihar to meet essential requirements such as industrial development, drinking water and irrigation.

He said that the Farakka Barrage has resulted in severe silt accumulation in the Ganga, making the river shallower. This has affected the river's natural flow and led to

increasingly serious flooding and erosion in areas of the Ganga basin.

Recently, severe erosion occurred in Bhagalpur district due to a change in the course of the Ganga. Senior officials camped there for a week, overseeing anti-erosion work on a war footing, and the embankment was secured.

The Deputy Chief Minister also said that, at Bihar's initiative, the Central Government has prepared a framework for a National Silt Management Policy, and further action on it is underway.

He said that recently, Bihar's water interests concerning Farakka were strongly presented before External Affairs Minister Dr S. Jaishankar and the Union Water Resources Minister CR Patil. The Central government has assured that, while taking decisions on matters related to Farakka, Bihar's drinking water and industrial water requirements will be taken into consideration.

MP intern doctors go on strike, demand hike in monthly stipend

Intern doctors in government medical colleges of Madhya Pradesh went on strike on Tuesday to demand an increase in their monthly stipend.

The protesting doctors also sat on the main road near Kamla Park in Bhopal and staged a road blockade.

Out Patient Departments (OPD) of government hospitals affiliated to medical colleges remained closed as a result of the strike and patients faced many difficulties.

The emergency services,

however, remained functional.

The interns are demanding a hike in their present stipend of Rs 14,337 to Rs 30,000 per month. The doctors alleged that the state government had verbally assured them of the hike in the past, but it has not yet fulfilled its promise.

On Monday evening, the protesting doctors had staged a march in Bhopal to gherao the official residence of Chief Minister Dr Mohan Yadav.

The police stopped them about 200 metres away from the CM's residence.

Several doctors had heated arguments with police

personnel and a few even clashed with them in an attempt to break the police barricade, and march towards the CM's residence.

The police resorted to using water cannons on the protesters to disperse them.

Some interns sustained injuries in the process, and alleged that the police treated them as if they were some unruly or anti-social elements.

Consequently, State Deputy Chief Minister and Health Minister Rajendra Shukla met with a delegation of intern doctors on Tuesday. He assured them that a proper

dialogue would be held with them over the stipend hike demand once CM Dr Yadav returns to Bhopal from his ongoing foreign trip to the United Arab Emirates from 6 to 9 September.

Shukla also directed Bhopal Police Commissioner Sanjay Kumar to initiate an investigation into the use of water cannon by police, and consequent injuries inflicted upon some of the interns.

Bhopal Police Commissionerate Deputy Police Commissioner (DCP) Zone-2, Vikas Sahwal, has been made the investigation in-charge.

Five young Orangutans rescued from Bichitrapur forest, wildlife smuggling suspected:

Baleswar: The rescue of five rare young Orangutans from the Bichitrapur casuarina forest near Badapai village in Baleswar district on Tuesday has raised suspicion of an organised wildlife-smuggling racket operating along Odisha's coastal belt.

The five endangered apes, believed to be around two years old, were spotted by villagers in the morning, who alerted the Udaipur forest officials. A team of forest personnel rushed to the spot and safely rescued the animals, which were found abandoned near the casuarina forest.

Officials said three of the Orangutans are females and two males. Veterinary surgeons examined them and found no major health problems, though the animals appeared disturbed following human interference. They have been kept temporarily at the Udaipur forest section office. Regional Chief Conservator of Forests-cum-Field Director of Simlipal Tiger Reserve Prakash Chand Gogineni said Orangutans are native to Indonesia and Malaysia and are not found in the wild in India.

Rahul slams MP govt over Sagar liquor tragedy, seeks impartial probe

Congress leader and Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday launched a sharp attack on the BJP government in Madhya Pradesh over the deaths allegedly caused by toxic liquor in Sagar, accusing the state administration of repeatedly failing to prevent such tragedies and demanding an impartial investigation to

establish responsibility at every level.

In a post on social media platform X, Gandhi alleged that effective governance had collapsed in Madhya Pradesh and accused the state government of allowing corruption and administrative failures to persist. He said the Sagar tragedy had plunged several families into mourning, but alleged that the official responses to such incidents had become a predictable cycle of farces, suspension of officials

and inquiries, without addressing the systemic failures that allowed them to occur.

Gandhi argued that the Sagar deaths could not be viewed as an isolated incident and referred to other tragedies in the state, including deaths in Indore following the consumption of contaminated water and the deaths of several children last year after allegedly consuming toxic cough syrup. Questioning the safety and regulation of essential commodities and

medicines, Gandhi said: *Dawa zahreeli. Sharab zahreeli. Paani zahreela.* He alleged that governments often introduced new laws and announced action after such incidents, but that these measures were subsequently neglected until another tragedy struck. The Congress leader also questioned the BJP's prolonged tenure in power in Madhya Pradesh and asked where accountability lay when preventive mechanisms repeatedly appeared to fail.
