

306 killed in ethnic violence since May '23: Manipur HM

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IMPACT: At least 306 people have been killed and 49 are still missing in the ethnic violence that broke out in May 2023, Manipur home minister Govindas Konthoujam informed the state's legislative assembly on Thursday.

The northeastern state was rocked by ethnic strife that broke out on May 3, 2023 between numerically dominant Meitei community that mostly inhabit Imphal Valley and tribal Kuki-Zo communities, who live primarily in the hill districts. Violent clashes broke out after a 'Tribal Solidarity March' was organised in the hill districts to protest against the Meitei community's demand for Scheduled Tribes (ST) status.

"Since the violence started on May 3, 2023, 306 people have died, and 49 people are still missing as of August 31, 2026," Konthoujam said, responding to a query by BJP legislator Sapam Ranjan Singh. The ethnic strife—which saw other communities like Nagas getting involved in the later stages—led to President's rule being imposed in the state on February 13 last year after the BJP-led government headed by Biren Singh resigned on February 9. It was

revoked on February 4 this year, hours before the formation of a new state government with BJP leader Y Khemchand Singh as chief minister.

The assembly proceedings also witnessed a war of words between the treasury and opposition benches when Congress legislator Kanglup Ranjit raised the issue of the killing of four Naga civilians in Kangpokpi district in May.

Konthoujam said four suspects had been arrested and that the National Investigation Agency (NIA) was investigating the case. When asked about allegations that cadres of Kuki National Front (PN) and its leader, who is the husband of deputy chief minister Nemecha King, were involved in the killings, the minister said: "There is no concrete information on whether KNF (PN) was involved in the killings or not."

"NIA is a premier agency in the country. We also pursue the case with them from time to time. We will try to ensure that justice is delivered," he added. Responding to the home minister, the Congress MLA said, "Please, work hard," and added, "Let's hand over the government to NIA."

Chief minister Y Khemchand Singh intervened, saying allegations made in public and findings of a probe were two different matters. "There was pressure that the village chief of Lelion Vailpet be arrested for his alleged involvement in the killing. However, when NIA investigated the case, it was learnt that the village chief was in Guwahati for medical treatment for more than a week before the incident happened," he said.

Kuki MLA Kinmeo Hoakip Hangshing on Thursday urged the state government to ensure the supply of food and medicines and fuel to every part of the state.

The Kuki People's Alliance MLA, along with Independent MLA, Hakoitolei Kingon, on Wednesday became the first Kuki legislators to attend a session of the Manipur Assembly in person since ethnic violence broke out in the state in May 2023.

BCI has no power to discipline law students: NALSAR episode

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NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Thursday delivered another rap on the knuckles to the Bar Council of India (BCI), making it clear that the lawyers' regulatory body has no statutory power or business to discipline students pursuing legal education, and cannot dictate to law universities how they should deal with student conduct.

Quashing the BCI's communications directing action against students of the 2026 graduating batch of NALSAR University of Law, Hyderabad, a bench headed by Chief Justice Surya Kant that said disciplinary control over law students rests exclusively with the university or educational institution where they are enrolled.

The bench, also comprising Justices Jayashree Agha and V. Ramesh, held that the Advocates Act, 1961, under which the BCI is constituted, did not confer on it either an express or implied power to take disciplinary action against students.

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A bench of Chief Justice of India (CJI) Surya Kant and Justices Jayashree Agha and V. Ramesh said that the high court was the appropriate forum as the alleged assaults took place at the BCI office in New Delhi.

"It should not appear as if everything must come to this court and that we have an institutional bias... You can approach the Delhi High court," the bench told advocate Prashant Bhushan, who mentioned the matter for urgent listing.

The bench questioned why the protesting lawyers had not used the legal mechanisms to raise their grievances, while acknowledging their right to protest. nrc

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UP PANEL IN TAIWAN, PITCHES STATE AS SEMICONDUCTOR INVESTMENT HUB

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Lucknow: A high-level delegation of the UP government held strategic discussions in Taiwan with global technology companies MediaTek and ADATA Technology pitching the state as a destination for semiconductor, electronics and advanced manufacturing investments.

Led by Alok Kumar, principal secretary, IT & Electronics, the delegation is on a tour to Taiwan from September 10 to 14. It met MediaTek chairman Ming-Kai Tsai to discuss the company's India operations and explore opportunities for expansion and diversification in Uttar Pradesh.

The talks focused on the state's growing electronics ecosystem, manufacturing infrastructure and potential role in strengthening the semiconductor supply chain. The delegation also met with the senior leadership of ADATA Technology to explore avenues for supporting the company's expansion in India. Prerna Sharma, additional CEO, Invest UP, and Manish Meena, additional CEO, YEIDA, participated in the discussions. The delegation used Taiwan visit and participation at SEMICON Taiwan to take its semiconductor and electronics investment pitch directly to global technology companies, opening discussions on expansion, manufacturing and supply-chain opportunities.

Pilot falls sick, IndiGo flight makes Mayday call, diverted to Oman

NEW DELHI: A Mayday call signalling a life-threatening emergency was made after one of the pilots of a Doha-Bengaluru IndiGo flight became incapacitated, prompting its diversion to Oman's Muscat International Airport on Thursday. Officials said the pilot required urgent medical attention and that flight 6E 1302 landed safely in Muscat, where a medical team attended to the affected crew member.

The pilot became incapacitated during the flight, and the Mayday emergency was declared, "an official said. It was not immediately clear whether the Airbus A320neo aircraft's first officer (co-pilot) or the pilot-in-command needed medical attention.

In a statement, IndiGo said the crew member is feeling better now. It added that an alternate aircraft and a new crew were arranged for the flight. The airline expressed its gratitude to the passengers who remained calm and cooperative throughout the incident.

The incident came two days after a Goa-Delhi IndiGo flight made an emergency landing shortly after take-off. A person aware of the matter said the

issue was related to one of the engines, even as IndiGo has not confirmed it.

It was the second IndiGo flight to face an engine snag in the past month. On August 1, a Kolkata-Chennai flight made a priority landing after declaring an emergency when its left engine developed problems on approach.

HT on Wednesday reported that "serious findings" were reported as the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) conducted safety audits of four major airlines ahead of a US Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) assessment of India's civil aviation regulator oversight scheduled between November 16 and 18.

The DGCA completed the safety audits in August, three months before a five-member FAA team will visit India.
