

₹100 cr grant for 100-bed CRIYN hosp near Guntur

State sanctions ₹9.94 cr for 15-acre site works with ops targeted to begin by 2028

THE Union Ministry of AYUSH has officially issued orders approving the establishment of a Central Research Institute of Yoga and Naturopathy (CRIYN) at Nadimpalem in Prathipadu mandal, near Guntur.

Announced by Health Minister Y Satya Kumar Yadav, the flagship project will be developed with a ₹100 crore central grant under the Central Council for Research in Yoga and Naturopathy (CCRYN) and will feature a 100-bed hospital alongside advanced research facilities.

To facilitate rapid execution, the State government has sanctioned ₹9.94 crore for ground-level preparation, including soil filling, boundary drainage, and a dedicated 40-foot approach road connecting the campus to NH-16.

Preliminary site work will address low-lying portions of the 15-acre plot that sit 2 to 3 metres below the highway level. The government allocated ₹6.74 crore for land requirements and ₹3.20 crore for ground filling and levelling, with covered drains planned to prevent waterlogging.

Following inspections by central and state authorities, all site preparation tasks are slated for completion within three

months, after which the developed parcel will be handed over to CCRYN for facility construction. AYUSH Commissioner Gopalakrishna Ronanki stated that full operational activities at the campus are projected to begin by 2028.

The integrated 100-bed healthcare institute is designed as a premier centre for non-invasive, drugless therapies targeting lifestyle disorders and chronic health conditions. The facility will offer dedicated outpatient and inpatient services.

In addition to gender-segregated therapy wings and yoga halls, the site will feature hydrotherapy, acupuncture, physiotherapy, a therapeutic naturopathy diet kitchen, walking tracks, medicinal plant gardens, and a 300-capacity conference auditorium.

Alongside, CRIYN will prioritise research and economic growth. The campus will house modern laboratories for Hematology, Biochemistry, Molecular Biology, and Neuro-psychophysiology to conduct clinical studies on medicine protocols.

The establishment will generate direct employment for 100 to 120 professionals, including 15 to 20 BNYS doctors, yoga therapists, physiotherapists, lab technicians, and administrative staff, serving as a pivotal wellness hub for the region.

Panel raises concern over Mangampeta barytes mines

A fact-finding committee on Thursday raised concern over the alleged gradual closure of Mangampeta barytes mines and large-scale mineral exports. The panel inspected reserves, bulk tenders, exports, APMDC policies and proposed closure. Mangampeta Barytes Protection Struggle Committee convenor Kandarpur Murali said the committee was formed after a Vijayawada round-table meeting to examine issues concerning the valuable, non-renewable resource.

The committee comprised former Minister Vadde Shobhanadreeswara Rao, retired IPS officer AB Venkateswara Rao, retired IAS officer B Srinivasa Rao, former MLCs KS Laxman Rao and M Geyanand, and social activist Vasundhara.

The committee said the Mangampeta, Obulavaripalle and Govindapalle areas were earlier estimated to have around 74 million tonnes of barytes reserves. It expressed concern that the mines, which have contributed to the economy, State revenue and local employment for more than five decades, were now allegedly being moved towards closure.

“Reserves reportedly declined from around 49 million tonnes in 2015 to about 23 million tonnes in 2024. It warned that continued large-scale exports could leave insufficient resources for future domestic requirements,” members of the committee opined. Members demanded a comprehensive inquiry into bulk tenders, Mangampeta revenues and others.

Suspension of 2 IPS officers revoked

THE government on Thursday revoked the suspension of two senior IPS officers - Kanthi Rana Tata and Vishal Gunni - and reinstated them into service with immediate effect.

Two separate orders were issued by Chief Secretary G Sai Prasad under clause (c) of sub-rule (7) of Rule 3 of the All India Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1969, lifting the suspension against two IPS officers and reinstating them to the service.

Both officers had been under suspension since September 2024 and their suspension had

been extended under Rule 3(1) of the AIS (D&A) Rules, 1969. The latest extensions were valid until September 4, 2026.

In case of Vishal Gunni, the government said it took the decision based on circumstances reported by the Director General of Police, Head of Police Force (HoPF). In case of Kanthi Rana Tata, the decision was taken after considering his representation dated August 24, 2026, along with the report of the DGP Harish Kumar Gupta.

Reinstatement is without prejudice to ongoing disciplinary and criminal proceedings; DGP will serve orders and obtain acknowledgements.

It may be recalled that the two IPS officers were suspended over the alleged high-handed handling of a case involving Mumbai-based actress and model Kadambari Jethwani. In 2024, the State government suspended five police officers, including then DGP (Intelligence) P Sitharama Anjaneyulu, NTR district Commissioner Kanthi Rana Tata, DCP Vishal Gunni, West Zone ACP K Hanumantha

Rao and Ibrahimpatnam Circle Inspector M Satyanarayana.

The Union Home Ministry confirmed the suspension of the three IPS officers, extending it by 180 days based on Review Committee recommendations. Gunni, suspended since September 15, 2024, challenged it before the CAT, which ordered his reinstatement. The State challenged the order in the HC, which stayed it.

Following that, both the officers submitted representations on August 24 seeking revocation. Based on their requests, the DGP recommended revocation, for which the Chief Secretary issued orders lifting the suspension on Thursday.

16-member panel to revise 25% free school admission norms under RTE

THE government constituted a 16-member state-level committee to revise the guidelines for providing 25% free admissions to students from economically weaker and disadvantaged sections in private schools.

The committee has been formed in accordance with Sec-

tion 12(1)(c) of the Right to Education (RTE) Act, 2009. The government has taken the decision to update the existing guidelines and strengthen their implementation across the State.

The move follows the Supreme Court's judgment delivered on January 13 this year and directions issued by the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights

(NCPCR). The revised guidelines are intended to bring the existing provisions in line with the court's judgment and the NCPCR directions.

The state-level committee will examine the existing regulations and recommend necessary amendments to ensure transparent and effective implementation of the 25 per cent free admission provision.

Yetapaka incident: 44 discharged

AS many as 44 of the 53 people who fell ill after consuming chloroquine tablets in Yetapaka mandal of Polavaram district have recovered and been discharged from Bhadrachalam Area Hospital, Collector K Dinesh Kumar said.

He said the forensic laboratory in Vizag had given a clean chit to the chloroquine tablets distributed in the village. Tests found their chemical composition to be normal, with the tablets having a shelf life until 2028 and no defects detected.

Authorities are investigating why 53 people developed symptoms after consuming the tablets. The tablets were distributed about two-and-a-half hours after children had food.
