Where will the trucks go? What about the trucks people have purchased? Now, fufaji has found something new to complain about,” Modi quipped, implying that opposition parties would go out of their way to manufacture grievances against national progress.

Days later, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar travelled to the Ukrainian capital of Kyiv and stated that India is ready to contribute whatever it can to bring peace to Ukraine. “We know the position of India on the Ukrainian conflict, and to a great extent, it corresponds with our own position because we do want the solution to the Ukraine conflict by peaceful means, and Russia is open for this process,” Peskov said. The Russian presidential spokesperson also said that Russia is waiting for negotiations with India on setting up

Coinciding with his visit, the Indian Navy’s INS Udayagiri, an advanced indigenous stealth guided-missile frigate, arrived at the Colombo port on Tuesday. The frigate was received in accordance with naval traditions, the Sri Lanka Navy said. Sri Lanka Navy personnel will also visit the frigate for capability familiarisation, knowledge sharing and onboard training, it said. The crew of INS Udayagiri will participate in goodwill events with the Sri Lanka Navy and visit tourist and cultural sites.

new nuclear plants. Selling of Su-57 aircraft to India is also on the agenda, he added. India is in the process of procuring a batch of fifth-generation fighter jets. Dassault Aviation’s Rafale, Lockheed Martin’s F-21, Boeing’s F/A-18 and the Eurofighter Typhoon are among the main contenders. Citing the personal chemistry between PM Modi and President Putin, Peskov said they are “very pragmatic” and sincere to be able to discuss in a “very open and constructive way” the most sensitive issues. Indian companies are interested in expanding their presence in the Russian market and investing in the Russian economy and “we appreciate that”, he said.

Navy chief to visit Aus, NZ from today to bolster maritime ties

NEW DELHI, Sept 8 (PTI)

THE Chief of the Naval Staff Admiral Krishna Swaminathan will undertake an official visit to Australia and New Zealand starting September 9, aiming to bolster naval cooperation and strengthen maritime ties with the two countries. During the visit, the Chief of the Naval Staff (CNS) will hold bilateral discussions with the senior leadership of the Royal Australian Navy (RAN) and

Royal New Zealand Navy (RNZN), officials said on Tuesday. The visit is aimed at further strengthening the Indian Navy’s bilateral cooperation with the two navies. “The visit to Australia builds upon the growing momentum in India-Australia relations, following the third India-Australia Annual Summit held in July 2026 and the second India-Australia Defence Ministers’ Dialogue held in June 2026,” a senior official said. The two countries have con-

Indian, Chinese armies hold second session of high-level dialogue on border situation

NEW DELHI, Sept 8 (PTI)

THE Indian and Chinese Armies held their first high-level commanders’ flag talks in two sessions on both sides of the frontier in the Arunachal Pradesh sector this week in line with the outcome reached at last month’s Special Representatives dialogue in Beijing, the Ministry of External Affairs said on Tuesday. National Security Advisor Ajit Doval had held the Special Representatives (SR) talks with Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi that focused on delimitation of the frontier and sustaining work on trans-boundary cooperation as well as to maintain peace along the Line of Actual Control (LAC).



MEA spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said the Senior Highest Military Commander-Level Flag Meeting was held at Wacha on the Indian side in Arunachal Pradesh on September 6 and Damai on the Chinese side on Sept

7. “Pursuant to the understandings reached between the Special Representatives of India and China in August 2025 and August 2026, and subsequent discussions at the Working Mechanism for Consultation and Coordination meetings held in Beijing and New Delhi in May and August 2026 respectively, the first Senior Highest Military Commander-Level Flag Meeting was held at Wacha on the Indian side in Arunachal Pradesh on Sept 6 and Damai on the Chinese side on Sept 7,” Jaiswal said at his weekly media briefing. “A similar mechanism also exists in the Western Sector,” he said. Jaiswal also said that ties between India and China are gradually moving towards “positive direction”. In his remarks at the SR meeting, Doval said that normalcy in the ties has been a direct result of both sides maintaining peace and tranquillity in the border areas.

Rs 60 cr ‘financial irregularities’ in TMC MP-linked newspaper: ED

KOLKATA, Sept 8 (PTI)

THE Enforcement Directorate (ED) detected alleged financial irregularities of around Rs 60 crore in an Urdu newspaper linked to TMC Rajya Sabha MP Nadimul Haque, during searches for over 24 hours, officials said on Tuesday. The marathon searches at premises linked to Haque and his media entity began on September 7 morning and were completed early Tuesday. “Financial records and digital documents are being examined to establish the trail of the transactions and determine the nature and source of the funds under investigation,” an ED official told PTI on condition of anonymity. The central probe agency is probing alleged illegal financial transactions involving the newspaper and is examining whether some of the funds were routed through hawala channels, sources said.

During the searches, ED officials examined bank transaction records, financial documents and digital material, and questioned Haque at his residence and office in Kolkata, he said. The ED investigators are also looking into the alleged movement of funds linked to the TMC, he said. According to ED sources, investigators found discrepancies relating to transactions worth around Rs 60 crore for which they could not immediately find satisfactory supporting records. The central probe agency is now examining whether the transactions were genuine business dealings or whether the funds were moved through informal channels, including hawala, the official said. Similar searches were conducted at seven other locations in Delhi and Ranchi, including the newspaper’s office in the city’s Park Circus area and premises linked to Haque.

Three held for forcing entry at shopping mall in Mumbai’s BKC; no link to PM’s event: Police

MUMBAI, Sept 8 (PTI)

THREE men have been arrested for allegedly forcing entry at a shopping mall in Bandra-Kurla Complex (BKC) here while carrying a firearm, police said on Tuesday, clarifying that the incident had no link to PM Narendra Modi’s scheduled event in the area on Tuesday evening. Earlier, a senior police official had said that a 24-year-old man, claiming to be a PMO official, and his armed ‘bodyguard’ had been detained at Nita Mukesh Ambani Cultural Centre in BKC hours before PM Modi’s event there on Tuesday evening. But police clarified later that the incident had occurred at Jio World Plaza

in BKC on Monday, and had no connection with the Prime Minister’s event. The three suspects tried to gain entry into the high-end shopping mall located in the commercial district. When security staff stopped them, the men produced a suspicious-looking Govt identity card, argued with the guards, and forced their way inside, a senior official said. One of them was carrying a firearm. Following a complaint by mall officials, the BKC Police registered a First Information Report (FIR) under Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) sections related to ‘impersonating a public servant’ and ‘unlawful entry while armed with a deadly weapon’.
