

Construction in water bodies... NGT's axe to fall on officials too

- Not just the encroacher, those who allowed it will also face the dock
- NGT gets tough on plea against constructions within FTL limits

Bhopal: The National Green Tribunal has taken a tough stance on encroachments and illegal construction in the Bhoj Wetland and other water bodies of the city, pressing for firm action against structures built within the Full Tank Level (FTL) limits of the city's tanks, following a two-day hearing.

Accountability beyond the encroacher

The Tribunal made pointed observations on protecting government land, stating that acting only against encroachers is not



enough — the conduct of concerned officials and the administrative machinery must also be examined. It held that if encroachment or illegal construction occurred due to official inaction or negligence, accountability must be fixed accordingly, adding that government land is nobody's ancestral property. The remarks came during the hearing of Rashid Noor Khan vs Collector Bhopal and Others, con-

cerning encroachment at the Bada Talab.

FTL demarcation to expose encroachments

The NGT stressed the need to clearly define the boundaries of the Bhoj Wetland and other water bodies based on Full Tank Level demarcation, which would help identify restricted zones and unauthorised construction. Its records point to unauthorised structures, marriage gardens,

commercial establishments and paved roads within the 50-metre no-construction zone around the FTL. The Tribunal also called for identification and protection of smaller ponds and water bodies under 2.25 hectares.

5.46 lakh hectares of forest land under encroachment

Citing Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change data published in March 2025, the Tribunal noted that nearly 5,46,089.45 hectares of forest land across the country remains encroached upon, underlining the need for strict action to safeguard public and environmental assets.

Next hearing on October 6

The Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board submitted an interim action report and sought four weeks to file a detailed one. The Tribunal has directed a comprehensive report before the next hearing, scheduled for October 6. Advocate Harshvardhan Tiwari represented applicant Rashid Noor Khan.



Guest faculty seek halt to fall-out

Bhopal: Guest faculty members on Thursday apprised former Chief Minister Digvijaya Singh of their concerns over the continuation of the 'fall-out' process, despite earlier assurances that it would be stopped. They said that during a guest faculty Mahapanchayat on September 11, 2023, then Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan had announced that the fall-out process would be discontinued.

Women guest faculty members told Singh that on August 28, 2026, Raksha Bandhan Day, Chief Minister Dr Mohan Yadav had tied rakhi from women guest facul-

ty members in Ujjain and assured them that the fall-out process would remain suspended until a regularisation policy was formulated.

However, they said Higher Education Minister Inder Singh Parmar had stated that the process would not be stopped. They alleged that guest faculty members who had served for decades were being removed.

Singh said the Congress supported their demands and urged the Government to set a definite timeframe for a regularisation and job-security policy and suspend the fall-out process until its implementation.

17 new tourist facilitation centers will open in Madhya Pradesh

Women will take charge, the project will expand to 33 districts.

Seventeen new tourist facilitation centers will open in Madhya Pradesh. The total number of these centers will increase to 20 under the STDW project.

Bhopal: The State Tourism Board is embarking on a major initiative to ensure the safety of tourists visiting the state and empower local women with self-reliance. Under this initiative, 17 new Tourist Facilitation Centers (TFCs) will soon be established.

These sites have been divided into clusters that will cover nearby tourist destinations. The centers will be built and operated by women. The number of such facilities will increase to 20 in the state.

Operated in Bhopal, Orchha and Maheshwar

In the first phase, three centers are successfully operating in Bhopal, Orchha, and Maheshwar. This initiative is being undertaken by the Tourism Board under the Safe Tourism for Women (STDW) project. Its primary objective is



to provide a safe, comfortable, and reliable environment for tourists traveling alone or in groups.

Women will get responsibility

According to Ranjana Mishra, Advisor (Safe Tourism Destination for Women), MP Tourism Board, this model will not only provide a quality and safe experience to the tourists, but will also prove to be a strong source of sustainable livelihood for women at the local level.

Special training given to ten thousand women:

Under the Safe Tourism for Women project, special skill training has been given to about ten thousand women across the state to increase the participation of women in the tourism sector.

The trained women have been skilled in services such as e-rickshaw operation, tour guiding, boating, cooking, hospitality, and front office management. The new TFCs will also be managed by these women's groups (clubs), with five to ten women deployed at each center as needed.



Dubey questions oil use for PM's birthday celebrations

Bhopal: All India Congress Committee spokesperson Abhay Dubey on Thursday questioned the proposed lighting of diyas as part of Prime Minister's birthday celebrations, saying it was inconsistent with the government's earlier appeal to reduce the consumption of edible oil.

Addressing a press conference at the Pradesh Congress Committee office, Dubey also extended birthday greetings to the Prime Minister and welcomed BJP national president Nitin Nabin on his first visit to Madhya Pradesh.

Referring to the Prime Minister's May 11 appeal for people to reduce edible oil consumption by 10 per cent, Dubey said reports suggested that around 100 crore diyas would be lit during the celebrations. He claimed that, at 15 ml of oil per diya, this would require around 1.5 crore litres of oil, worth approximately Rs 225 crore at Rs 150 per litre.

Dubey said the BJP should instead use its resources to support people affected by disasters. He pointed to the Bihar floods, in which official figures showed around 49.36 lakh people across 15 districts had been affected as of September 14.

He also referred to recent tragedies reported in Madhya Pradesh and said Nitin Nabin should show greater sensitivity towards people facing hardship.

"Where the lamps of homes have been extinguished, diyas should not be lit," Dubey said.

Bhopal: Shiv Kumar Prasad, Chief Coach at the Madhya Pradesh State Athletics Academy, Bhopal, has been named to the selection committee for the Indian athletics team competing at the ISF Gymnasiade 2026, an international school sports event. The nomination was communicated through an official letter issued by School Games Federation of India (SGFI) CEO Parth Suresh Doshi on September 12, 2026.



Prasad will play a key role in finalising the Un-

der-18 boys' and girls' teams during selection trials scheduled for October 6-7 at Atal Stadium, Bambolim, North Goa. He has been relieved of duties from October 5-8 and directed to report at the trial venue on October 5.

The ISF Gymnasiade 2026 will be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, from December 3-8, bringing together young athletes on a global school sports platform.

As Chief Coach at the Academy, Prasad oversees training, technical guidance and competition preparation for athletes, several of whom — including Dev Meena, Kuldeep Kumar and Samardeep Singh Gill — have excelled nationally and internationally in pole vault and shot put. His selection marks a proud moment for Madhya Pradesh's sports training ecosystem.
