

1,008 lamps lit to mark PM Narendra Modi's birthday

BELAGAVI, DHNS: BJP Belagavi Dakshin, led by MLA Abhay Patil, lit 1,008 earthen lamps as part of an ‘Ashirwad Ka Diya’ programme at Kala Mandir here on Thursday evening to mark Prime Minister Narendra Modi’s 76th birthday.

The Kala Mandir premises glowed with the light of the earthen lamps as the event was held to wish Modi and express support for his continued service to the nation. A song dedicated to Modi was also played during the programme.

The lamps were arranged in the shape of ‘Modi 25×365=9125’, highlighting his 13-year tenure as chief minister of Gujarat and 12 years as prime minister.

9 taluks declared drought-affected

BELAGAVI, DHNS: Nine taluks in Belagavi district have been declared drought-affected by the state government in the second list released on Thursday.

None of the district’s taluks figured in the first list of drought-affected taluks. The nine taluks have now been included in the second list based on rainfall data recorded from June 1 to September 16.

Athani, Bailhongal, Belagavi, Chikkodi, Raibag, Channamma Kittur, Nippani, Mudalgi and Yargatti have been declared drought-affected. Athani has been classified as severely drought-affected, while the remaining eight taluks have been categorised as moderately drought-affected.

Ramdurg and Savadatti taluks have not been included in the drought-affected list.

Elephant herd strays into paddy fields near Bhimgad

Officials monitor nine pachyderms including tusker, two calves

A herd of nine elephants, including two calves and a tusker, has strayed close to human habitation in villages near the Bhimgad Wildlife Sanctuary in Khanapur taluk, prompting the Forest Department to launch efforts to drive the animals back into the forest.

The herd, comprising one tusker, six adult elephants and two calves, has been moving around Pali, Hemmadga, Abanali, Dongargaon and Shiroliwada villages for the past week. On Wednesday night, Forest Department officials spotted the herd near Pali village and launched a drive to push the animals back into the forest.

However, the herd split during the operation after firecrackers were burst to drive them away. Seven elephants were later spotted near Pali and two near Abanali, moving through paddy fields. Forest Department personnel, assisted by

local residents, continued to monitor their movement.

Assistant Conservator of Forests Basavaraj Walad and Range Forest Officer Sayyadsab Nadaf led the operation.

Walad said the elephants were first spotted by a motorcyclist near Pali, but the herd had moved away before Forest Department personnel reached the spot.

“This is the first time elephant movement has been noticed in the Belagavi division forests. We are using drones and have deployed staff to monitor their movement,” Walad said.

Farmers have told Forest Department officials that the elephants have damaged standing paddy crops and urged them to drive the herd back into the forest.

Officials suspect that the elephants may have strayed from the forests around Haliyal, Castle Rock, Jagalbet, Tinaghat and Ganesghudi in search of food and water.

As the herd includes a tusker, officials have warned residents against approaching the elephants or bursting firecrackers to drive them away.

Deputy Conservator of Forests Kranti N E said efforts were being made to safely drive the herd back into the forest.

MP ensures full ‘Vande Mataram’ is played

BELAGAVI, DHNS: BJP MP Jagadish Shettar ensured that the national song ‘Vande Mataram’ was played in full during a programme organised at the Belagavi Institute of Medical Sciences (BIMS) here on Thursday.

The 76th Samajik Adhikarta Shivir was organised at the BIMS auditorium to distribute assistive devices and aids

to persons with disabilities under various Central government schemes, marking Prime Minister Narendra Modi’s 76th birthday.

As the programme began, only the first two paragraphs of ‘Vande Mataram’ were sung.

Shettar directed the BIMS staff to play the complete song.

State should come to aid of drought-hit people: Shettar

Seeks drought status for 180+ taluks, immediate relief

MP Jagadish Shettar on Thursday alleged that more than 180 taluks in the state were reeling under drought and urged the state government to immediately declare them drought-affected and commence relief works.

Speaking to reporters here, Shettar said Chief Minister D K Shivakumar should stop blaming the Centre and waiting for National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) funds, and instead come to the aid of people facing distress.

He alleged that the Congress government had failed to release funds for development works and that contractors’ dues had accumulated to more than Rs 30,000 crore.

“Ramdurg, Savadatti and Yargatti taluks in Belagavi are facing severe drought, and agricultural yields are likely to be badly affected. The government should stop discrimination and declare more than 180 taluks as drought-affected,” Shettar said.

BJP celebration

The BJP will celebrate the achievements of Prime Minister Narendra Modi over the past 25 years on the occasion of his 76th birthday. The month-long programme will be held from September 17 to October 17.

Modi served as the chief minister of Gujarat for 13 years and has been serving as prime minister for the past 12 years. During the month-long

celebrations, people will be informed about his achievements and various development initiatives undertaken during his tenure. “We have inaugurated a bus stop here using MP funds, while assistive devices are being distributed to persons with disabilities at the Belagavi Institute of Medical Sciences under a central government-funded programme,” Shettar said.

He claimed that the BJP government, when it was in power, had not waited for assistance from the Centre to declare drought-affected areas and had initiated relief measures.

The Congress government,

he alleged, was delaying the declaration of drought-affected taluks citing technical reasons.

Shettar also criticised Shivakumar, saying that despite promising good governance after assuming office, the

chief minister had failed to adequately address the problems faced by people.

“Instead of coming to the aid of people, the chief minister has been touring across the state to overtake former chief minister Siddaramaiah and showcase himself,” he alleged. Shettar said development activities had been affected and contractors’ payments were pending.

He also alleged that both Central and state funded projects had been hit. “In the coming days, even government vehicles may not get fuel, as dues to fuel stations have not been cleared for the past eight months,” he claimed.

Railway project

Shettar said the Centre had released Rs 960 crore for the Belagavi-Channamma Kittur-Dharwad direct railway line and that land acquisition was nearing completion.

According to him, landowners were to be paid around Rs 500 crore as compensation, but the state government had released only Rs 50 crore eight months ago, resulting in delay to the project.

He referred to the Enforcement Directorate (ED) searches involving Public Works Department Minister Satish Jarkiholi and alleged that complaints against him had been made by Congress leaders themselves.

Farmers demand Rs 4,500 per tonne FRP for sugarcane

The Karnataka Farmers Organisations Federation has urged the Centre to fix the Fair and Remunerative Price (FRP) for sugarcane at Rs 4,500 per tonne and asked the state government to announce an additional Rs 800 per tonne as State Advisory Price (SAP), on the lines of Tamil Nadu, citing a rise in sugarcane production costs.

The demands were raised at an executive committee meeting of the farmers’ organisation held here on Wednesday. A memorandum outlining the demands was submitted to the deputy commissioner.

State Sugarcane Growers’ Association president Kurbar

Shantkumar told reporters that there are 29 sugar factories in Belagavi district, but several factories were deducting harvesting and transportation charges from farmers’ bills, causing financial losses to growers.

He said the state government had fixed harvesting charges at Rs 512 per tonne and transportation charges at Rs 279 per tonne. As per the FRP regulations and the Sugarcane (Control) Order, sugar factories are required to clear farmers’ dues within 14 days.

The deputy commissioner should take necessary measures to ensure timely payment, he said.

Based on sugar recovery, sugar factories in the district

were required to pay farmers Rs 3,400 to Rs 3,500 per tonne for sugarcane during the previous year. However, farmers were paid around Rs 3,300 per tonne, leaving an additional Rs 200 per tonne to be paid, Shantkumar claimed. As transportation tariffs have already been fixed by the state government, measures should be taken to ensure that farmers are not charged beyond the prescribed rates, he demanded.

To prevent farmers from being cheated, Shantkumar urged the district administration to convene monthly meetings involving farmers’ representatives and sugar factory representatives to monitor sugarcane harvesting and transportation charges.
