Two sentenced to
life imprisonment
in murder case

THE Fifth Additional Dis-
trict and Sessions Court in
Mangaluru, sitting at
Puttur, has sentenced Kiran
and Preethesh to life im-
prisonment and imposed a
fine of Rs 3 lakh each in
connection with the mur-
der of Karthik Suvarna
Merla in 2019.

Karthik, a resident of
Merla in Aryapu village,
was hacked to death dur-
ing a Ganeshotsava pro-
gramme in 2019.

Following the incident,
Puttur Rural Police regis-
tered a case under Sec-
tions 504, 341, 302 and 212
of the Indian Penal Code
(IPC). Then Puttur Rural
Police Inspector Nagesh
Kadri investigated the
case and filed a chargesheet
against four accused: Pree-
thesh, Charan, Kiran and
Stevan Monterio. Judge
Sadananda Naik pro-
nounced the judgment,
sentencing Kiran and
Preethesh to life imprison-
ment and imposing a fine of
Rs 3 lakh under Section

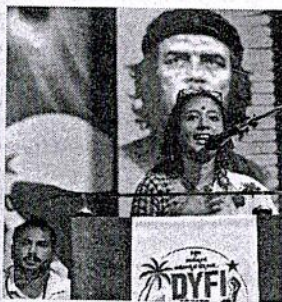

No difference between DKS & Modi in terms of economic policies'

TH leader and activist from West Bengal Dip Dhar alleged that the government, led by the Minister Narendra Modi, has been in power since 2014 with the slogan 'Saath, Sabka Vikas', but has failed to transform India into a developed nation. She also alleged that instead of giving a Vikas Purush, Narendra Modi has turned out to be a Vanaash Purush. She was speaking after inaugurating the 15th Dakshina Kannada District Youth Federation of (DYFI) on Sunday at P. Jathana Hall, Mangaluru. She alleged that the BJP government portrays students fighting for quality education against corruption in the education sector as anti-national. She was also speaking at a protest at Mantar over the question paper leak,

she said the students who raised their voices against the issue were labelled anti-national. "If raising our voice for the people is anti-national, then we are ready to be called anti-nationals," she said.

Dhar alleged that since the BJP came to power, attempts had been made to divide the country by spreading hatred, threatening unity. She called for collective efforts to oppose communalism.

She also alleged that farmers and workers were facing difficulties under

the BJP government and claimed that several measures taken by the Centre had affected their rights.

Referring to employment reservations for locals, Dhar alleged that the Siddaramaiah government's cabinet had approved the policy in 2024 but withdrew it the following day after pressure from industrialists.

She questioned whether Chief Minister D K Shivakumar would provide such reservations and alleged that there was no difference between Shivakumar and Modi in terms of economic policies. She further alleged that the RSS and BJP were attempting to influence Karnataka's cultural traditions, including Yakshagana to propagate RSS ideologies.

"We carry forward the ideas of Bhagat Singh, Rajguru, Sukhdev, Savitribai Phule and Narayana Guru. We can never be divided. Humanity comes first, there is no religion greater than humanity," she said.
