Farmers seek permanent fix to Georai water crisis

Battling recurrent drought for generations, farmers from Georai tehsil have once again approached the state administration, seeking a permanent solution to the region's chronic water crisis.

In a memorandum submitted to Deputy Chief Minister and Guardian Minister Sunetra Pawar, a delegation of farmers and activists demanded that surplus water from the Godavari river basin and the Paithan Right Bank Canal be diverted to key local reservoirs through dedicated lift pipelines or sub-canal.

The delegation identified six critical reservoirs in Georai tehsil — Chaklamba, Shekta, Bangali Pimpila,

Goarakshnath Kumbhajaalgaon, Govindwadi and Georai. According to the farmers, replenishing these reservoirs even once could help sustain local water bodies, streams and groundwater levels for up to three consecutive years.

"Generations of farmers here have been scorched by relentless drought," the memorandum stated, adding that supplying water through pipelines from Shahagad,

Panchaleshwar or Gulaj could bring thousands of hectares of parched and remote farmland under irrigation.

The farmers also argued that a permanent pipeline project would reduce the government's recurring expenditure on drought relief. Each drought cycle requires the state to spend crores of rupees on water tankers, cattle camps and temporary drinking-water

arrangements, they said.

The demand is not new. Local farmers said they have been petitioning the state government since 2012 and submitted records of previous agitations, memorandums and unfulfilled administrative assurances along with their latest representation.

Copies of the memorandum were also submitted to the Chief Minister, Water Resources Department, local representatives and community leaders. The delegation included farmer activist Manoj Patil, Laxman Aaher, Irshad Bhai, Abasaheb Aaher, Ramchandra Kale, Balasaheb Aaher and Machhindra Karbhari, representing farmers from Khalegaon and surrounding villages in Georai tehsil.

No immersion, no home idols: Helas village's unique Ganeshotsav

The 138-year-old Ganesh festival at Helas village in Mantha taluka is drawing attention for its distinctive traditions that combine religious devotion, environmental conservation and cultural activities.

Located about five kilometres from Mantha, Helas is a village of around 3,500 people from different communities. According to the Shri Ganesh Sansthan, the village has been observing its unique Ganesh festival for 138 years, with records indicating that the tradition predates the public Ganesh festival movement associated with Lokmanya Tilak.

Unlike conventional celebrations, residents do not install separate Ganesh idols in their homes or conduct immersion processions. The

focus is on an ancient east-facing Ganesh idol housed in a central Hemadpanthi temple, regarded by villagers as the village deity.

The festival begins with worship of the temple idol and the traditional Bhagwat Katha. It concludes with Palakhi Purnima, marked by Maha Aarti, Mahaprasad and an overnight palanquin procession through the village. The palanquin is carried on devotees' shoulders and, according to the organisers, is not placed on the ground during the procession.

The festival also has a strong social dimension. Married daughters born in Helas return to their maternal village with their families, making the occasion a major reunion for several generations.

Another important feature is the village's musical theatre tradition. Three plays are staged every year, with young residents rehearsing for nearly a month before Ganesh Chaturthi. The tradition includes social, religious and humorous themes and has historically featured plays aimed at promoting social awareness and unity.

The organisers say the festival is conducted without DJs or high-volume sound systems and without idol immersion, thereby avoiding associated noise and water pollution.

Min Bharne inspects drought

State Agriculture Minister Dattatray Bharne inspected soybean crops and assessed the drought situation in the farmlands of Hiwara Jatu in Aundha Nagnath taluka of Hingoli district on Saturday. Following the inspection, he had a traditional

meal of besan-bhakari at the farm of farmer Shankar Datarao Karhale.

A drought-like situation has emerged in Hingoli district, including Aundha Nagnath taluka. Against this backdrop, Agriculture Minister Bharne personally inspected the standing crops at Hiwara Jatu and interacted with farmers.

During the visit, farmers apprised the minister of their grievances. In response, Bharne assured them that assistance would soon be provided through various government schemes. Rajya Sabha member Ramrao Vadkute, MLA Chandrakant (alias Raju) Navghare and others were present.

The Shetkari Kamgar Party (SKP) on Monday took out a bullock-cart morcha to the Kaij tehsil office, demanding immediate financial assistance for farmers and measures to address the agrarian crisis caused by

inadequate rainfall this year.

Led by SKP district unit general secretary Bhai Mohan Gund, the protesters demanded compensation of ₹50,000 per hectare for farmers who suffered crop losses during the kharif season. They also sought the immediate opening of fodder camps, payment of pending

crop insurance claims from previous years and withdrawal of the alleged compulsion to install smart (prepaid) electricity meters.

The march reached the tehsil office around 1pm, where it turned into a public meeting. Addressing the gathering, Gund said prolonged rainfall deficiency and

extensive crop damage had left farmers in a critical financial situation. He demanded that the government declare the affected areas drought-hit and provide immediate relief.

The protesters also demanded a complete waiver of electricity bills for agricultural pumps and domestic consumption,

along with at least eight hours of uninterrupted daytime power supply for agricultural pumps. They sought the immediate release of pending crop insurance compensation for the 2024 kharif and rabi seasons and payment of the second instalment of sugarcane dues by sugar factories in the district.
